3. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

5. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Dunovan shared his report:

- Winter certainly threw a wrench into our Exam schedule; however, we are finished! This may delay report cards slightly from the original send out date.
- Exams written in the gym vs classroom. Feedback will be requested of students this month in the monthly student survey.
- Principal's Student Advisory to meet at least once monthly (except June)
- Winter Fair is coming up next week - all events will be indoors.
- The Sharks Mural panels are finally installed in the gym. The art department is once again supporting with the next set of panels.
- The school is still waiting for the banners to be taken down and the painting to be completed in the gym.
- Dunovan is waiting to complete the contract with Minute Man Press for the Banner installation in the gym.
- The Operations Department and their insurance provider did an excellent job fixing the school's main office space after the flood. We are still unpacking in small bits as we have time.
- Parents, Chris and Maggie Richards, have been super supportive of our fundraising efforts for the gym bleachers. They are parents and business owners in the community.
- We now have \$23K in funds of the estimated \$50k we are looking to raise for our bleachers and we are waiting on the next report in late February to see how much has come in online.
- Our SAC current funds are: \$6,079.62
- The school is seeking \$2k in those funds from SAC to support the bleachers project.
- Dunovan is also seeking \$4k to provide resources for Math support. This money would be used to directly support our indigenous students and students of African descent as priority learners.

Daniel asked the question re: if there are any other financial asks. For example, is there a need for spending in the area of literacy

- Some SAC members indicated approval of the requests outlined by Dunovan. Todd reminded everyone of the need for a pause to field questions from other SAC members
- Questions were asked regarding the benefit and the long-term results of the ANS and Indigenous students who received the additional math support last year. People were asking if there was a way that we could ensure more follow-up / greater transfer of the skills they were learning with the extra support teacher to their work in class (and in future grades).
- We discussed the idea of tracking the data - watching how those students do in their subsequent courses (i.e. Did the intervention allow those kids to keep on the Academic math path?)

- There was some concern raised re: spending that much of the SAC's money on servicing a small subsection of the community
- It was also asked if we could possibly ' earmark ' or budget for that expenditure now, but not spend it yet?
- Todd suggested that we pause the decision re: to spend/not spend until we collect more data
- Dunovan will ask Cara (Math Department Head) to gather and share information/data re: the benefit of the extra math help
- The price for that additional math support is \$245 / day for the substitute. This information will be considered when the SAC is trying to decide how much to set aside for each (bleachers and math support)
- There was also a question asked: when would Dunovan need to know how much SAC is willing to allot to Math Support. Dunovan will update us in April (do we need money? or can it wait?).

5. OTHER BUSINESS

- Dunovan talked about the upcoming Band trip to Montreal; Students will experience the music and the culture of the province, including various tours and performances. The students will be fundraising and traveling by bus
- Dunovan and Todd provided an update on the SAC Conference - Overall, it seemed well attended. Participants reviewed the SAC handbook; Learned about the challenges some of the other SAC's experience; Learned about what kinds of data we can ask for / expect from school administration.

8. FINANCE:

9. SPECIAL REPORTS OR PRESENTATIONS:

a. Student Council's Report

- Report on the Grade 9 Orientation - note for next year: provide clearer coordination with teachers on how long each presentation should be in each room along the tour
