## 4. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Dunovan shared his report:

- The Europe and Galapagos trips have had their parent meetings.
- In the Fall 2027 there will be another trip to Greece and Italy. That parent meeting will happen soon.
- Dunovan has officially received confirmation of \$30k in funds from Councillors Nancy Hartling and Janet Steele. On May 15th there will be a presentation of these funds. The fundraising auction at Brunello will happen the end of May - we are hoping to raise enough to cover the balance of the \$60,000 that needs to be raised (the auction would need to bring in approximately \$9000)
- Dunovan indicated that the SAC funds have been transferred to Bleacher Fund.
- As of May 15, we will have \$51K in the Bleacher Fund account. We are hoping to reach \$60k before the end of June.
- The Provincial Funding application will go in September unless the application process opens before the end of June.
- BV has just finished several weeks of Math Coaching to support Math 10 teachers. The Math Coach worked with two specific teachers, tried some new resources, and provided new ideas for reaching students. Getting good feedback from students. Much PD was provided to teachers.
- Our 50% teacher has been scheduled and is now supporting Math 10 students/staff. The purpose is to cover the class once the instruction has been given (and students are working) so the teacher can give more individualized attention to the students in their room.
- AP Exams are happening this week so there are no bells happening in the building this week. It would be interesting to get some feedback from students as to whether/not they like not having bells. Teachers seem to be in favour.
- 'Ready Set Bloom' will have a Petting Zoo (with Hatfield Farms - students need to have consent form signed before they can interact with animals), Glow Productions fun (obstacle race), lots of classroom activities, and time for students and staff to build deeper connections.
- Jack.Org Mental Health Fair this past week was a great success
- Gabby Clancy, granddaughter for the late Eddie Carvery, entered the Buddy Daye competition and won! She will be presented with her award at Alderney Landing on May 20th and Dunovan will attend in support. A fantastic accomplishment!
