5. OLD BUSINESS

- Update on new interest in SAC - no updates at this time.
- Update on Parking Passes: Students are 95% compliant at this time. The hiccup is coming up with a temporary parking pass for substitutes and itinerant staff. The school has some old parking passes. Will make a note in the on-line substitutes, reminding them to stop by the office. Next step (after given ample warnings), cars with no passes will be towed.
- Update on school play: *Cinderella*. Will run November 25-28. This even required lots of hard work on the part of students, staff, and community members. Tickets were 100% sold out
- Update on Student Success plan: moving forward on the plan as was provided and outlined by Dunovan.

6. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

- Reporting period is right around the corner, Dec. 4 - Progress Conferences & Teacher Professional Practice Day - no classes all schools
- There has been amazing progress for the musical students who have been practicing 3 times a week with a full night on Wednesdays. We are sold out, get your tickets while you can! Dunovan offered a huge thanks to all the staff and volunteers who were supporting this project - there are so many hands at work!
- Grade level assemblies were being held this Friday (November) to celebrate successes and provide a refresher of expectations, especially around cell phone use at school.

Todd asked a question regarding what the school is seeing in response to the cell phone. Dunovan indicated that the response is largely positive. Students reporting better focus and attention. Staff / admin noticing far less cyber bullying. Less time spent on discipline related to online/phones.
- Still waiting on folks to complete the meeting schedule survey for second semester SAC meetings.
- Dunovan met with *Minute Man Press* regarding celebration of sports excellence with banner panels for the gymnasium.
- Still waiting for Operations to follow through with installation of first panels for Shark Tank mural - looks like it should be happening in the next couple of weeks.
- The Corporate Letter campaign is providing some revenue for the bleacher fundraiser but there is still a long way to go. Link for donations on the website for anyone to access. We can't even get an estimate until we have a third of the funds raised.
- The SAC should see our budget before the end of this month.

- The school hosted a very successful Indigenous Heritage night. Some incredible experiences for our youth who got to participate in Indigenous Elder led singing, drumming, and dancing.
- *Fun Day* afternoon will be bumped to December as a 'Winter Fair' type of afternoon just before the break.: December 18th - the day before the last day of classes
- Letter program committee meeting with student members held today. Jess Atwater will provide a quick summary. Some ideas to consider: badges that could be earned for various accomplishments; a sash to wear at graduation; coloured beads that could be added to a leather bracelet - which could also include a shark's tooth
- Student Advisory to admin applicants will be selected next week. Trying to keep the number between 12 and 15 at the most, which is proving to be a difficult task
- Cell phones continue to be a challenge in the hallways. Admin was looking forward to the reset on Friday to help address the issue and reduce discipline response needs in this area.
